Introduction

The programme targeted female student participants at the graduate and post-graduate level

The programme started with the Welcome Speech from the Programme Co-ordinator Mr. R.Vijay Krishna, Entrepreneurship Promotion & Incubation Center Incharge, NRIIT which was followed by inaugural address by Dr.C.Naga Bhaskar, Principal, NRIIT. The Keynote Address was delivered by Chief Guest Dr. R.Venkata Rao, Chairman, NRIIT. The technical sessions of the programme were conducted by resource persons; Dr. R. Madhavi, Dr. T. Sree Latha, Dr. N.V. Surendra Babu and Dr. R. Sunitha who covered their respective sessions on various aspects in relation to the focus areas of the programme.

About National Commission for Women

The National Commission for Women was set up as statutory body in January 1992 under the National Commission for Women Act, 1990 (Act No. 20 of 1990 of Govt.of India) to: review the Constitutional and Legal safeguards for women; recommend remedial legislative measures; facilitate redressal of grievances and advise Government on all policy matters affecting women.

Course content.

- 1. Personal Capacity Building
- 2. Professional -Career Skills
- 3. Digital Literacy & Effective use of social media

Total time duration: 4.5 Hours (1.5 hours per session)

Technical Session 1: Personal Capacity Building

Dr R. Madhavi Assoc. Prof. English, Ch.S.D.St Theresa's College for Women, Eluru led the first technical session on "Personal Capacity Building". The objective of the session was to make learners engage in effective communication by respecting diversity and embracing good listening skills. The course made special focus on practicing interpersonal skills for better relations with seniors, juniors, peers and stakeholders. The session also focused on understanding the importance of documentation of key critical ideas/thoughts articulated and action points to be implemented.

The session aims at training students to strengthen their skills ineffective communication, personal excellence and sustainable development in order to thrive in a fast-changing world and dynamic workplace requirements.

The 1st module on Listening and Brainstorming comprises of aspects such as the relevance and aspects of active listening in the work place and academic world. The key features of active listening and the factors that make or mar good listening were discussed. Furthermore, the role played by listening in creation of ideas in brainstorming were brought out. The key aspects of brainstorming for ideation to advance careers are highlighted.

In the 2nd unit Time Management and Stress Management the relevance of Time Management in today's result driven world was brought out. The strategies to manage time are highlighted. The session also delved into the impact, factors and types of stress. It also highlighted the ways to overcome stress.

The 3rd Unit on Internal Communication and Group Discussion explained about the role played by Internal Communication in an organisation. The session-oriented students on the process of how messages can be delivered through formal and informal communication in the work place. The process, direction and forms of internal communication are discussed. Furthermore, the importance of group discussions and the strategies to participate in a good Group Discussion were touched upon.

Technical Session 2: Professional -Career Skills

The second technical session addressed professional career skills and was presented by **Dr. Sree Latha Tangirala**, Associate Professor & Head-Training, in Training & Placement Cell, NRIIT began with Identifying Career Opportunities and Resume Skills, and **Dr.N.V.Surendra Bahn**, Director-Training and Placements, NRIIT finished with interview Skills and Presentation Skills

Dr. Sree Latha Tangirala aimed at the final year and pre-final girl students to assist them learn the skills necessary for their professional and career aspects. Focus was laid more on imparting ways to grab the best career opportunities and plan for laying a clear career path basing on their respective educational qualification and other skills. Special emphasis was on women aspirants who hope for a better professional life. The efficacy of the presentation was enhanced by involving the participants actively in enthusiastic interaction and making the session highly informative and useful.

The presentation dealt with the details of choosing suitable career path; finding out different avenues for identifying relevant job opportunities; matching one's qualification, skills and other interests: drafting an impressive resume comprising the purpose, methods, key components, difference between a resume and curriculum vitae, lexis and style, tone and standard of writing etc. It further dealt with the need of a cover letter; the do's and don'ts of preparing a suitably convincing resume and other relevant information.

Finally, the outcome of the presentation enabled the students identify a suitable professional line to approach, prepare a well-defined resume including all necessary components and make best use of the opportunity to plan their future sensibly.

Dr.N.V.Surendra Babu guided the participants on how to write an appropriate resume, fill in the necessary gaps during interviews, and effectively communicate their skill set during his session. As per his recommendations, a good resume should contain the following features: Skills-focused, easy to read and understand, visually compelling without gimmicks, One page or no more than two pages in length and also emphasized that one's interview skills give an interviewer insight into how you will communicate in the workplace and solve problems. It also shows if you can actively listen and be honest in your work. All these factors tell your

potential employers how well you will fit in their work environment. Presentation skills can be defined as a set of abilities that enable an individual to: interact with the audience; transmit the messages with clarity; engage the audience in the presentation; and interpret and understand the mindsets of the listeners. These skills refine the way you put forward your messages and enhance your persuasive powers.

The present era places great emphasis on good presentation skills. This is because they play an important role in convincing the clients and customers. Internally, management with good presentation skills is better able to communicate the mission and vision of the organization to the employees.

Technical Session 3: Digital Literacy & Effective use of social media

The third technical session discussed "Digital Literacy and Effective Use of Social Media" by **Dr. Sunitha Ravi**, Women Protection and Grievance Cell Incharge, NRIIT.

During the presentation, the resource person highlighted on social networking as one of the most popular online activities, allowing us to communicate, share information, photographs, and videos with anyone around the world and illustrate the potential negative implications of social media, including cyber blackmailing, cyber stalking, bullying, fake profiles, morphing, and indecent representation of women.

As part of the presentation, Dr. Sunitha Ravi also shared short videos showing how social media is used to trigger young individuals to take their own lives, as well as how people can quickly repost a feed on social media with a different message. The students were therefore encouraged to be cautious and to always read the terms and conditions before accepting, to be alerted if someone attempts to access their account, and many more tips to help them stay safe. During this session, the female students learned how to effectively use social media by becoming cyberaware.

Finally, students are taught how to create social media profiles and safeguard them from hackers. Details on how to safeguard passwords and adjust privacy settings are provided in great depth.

Conclusion

The CBPD programme was very informative and interesting as it encompassed of both lectures and technical inputs that was found to be very helpful for the student participants. The contents of the programme in the different sessions covered a broad perspective that has helped the participants gain knowledge and make effective use of the inputs to enhance their skills for personal development, career and professional development, and wisely use digital media. Apart from the academic achievements, capacitating these skills to students is of core importance to meet the demands of the present day as they serve as supplement and catalyst to the academic achievement of the students for their personal and professional development, which would contribute to both individual and social growth and progress. With the emerging trend of excessive use of digital media in the present era, technological knowhow and soft skills are one of those important attributes for human resource development. Perhaps similar programmes should always be promoted in every academic session so that students do not only take away academic certificates with them but also sets of skills that would empower them in the long run.
