2.4 EXAMINATION MATTERS

To Consider and approve Question Paper Setting Process Item 2.4.1:

As a part of implementation of autonomy it is necessary to frame our own procedure for conducting the examinations.

Keeping in view the guidelines given by UGC, An Autonomous Examination Section was established for conducting examinations to various UG and PG Programmes. A systematic procedure for Question paper setting process has been prepared by a committee appointed by the principal consisting of all the Heads of the departments. A series of meetings were held to meet necessary changes and for a making final draft. The Paper setting Process discussed in the Common BOS and suggested changes were made to propose to academic council.

The following is the Proposed procedure for the Question Paper Setting Process:

- The question paper shall consists of questions / problems / experiments etc. that are within the scope of the syllabus of concern course that has been prepared by the Board of Studies and approved by Academic council.
- A panel of 6 examiners per subject be suggested by the concerned BOS
- The Panel of Examiners shall be from different universities/reputed institutions based on their experience
- The model of question papers shall be approved by the concerned BOS
- The Principal, who is the Chairman of Academic Council shall pick one examiner for paper setting from the panel and shall be intimated to the concerned Additional Controller of Examinations and the process is strictly confidential.
- Appointed two paper setters will be requested to prepare two sets for each subject.
- The following material shall be supplied to the paper setter along with appointment order.
 - Copy of Syllabus of concerned course
 - Model Question papers
 - ➢ Blooms taxonomy chart
 - > Guidelines for paper setting
 - > Text Books Prescribed
 - Blank format of Question paper and scheme of valuation
 - ≥2 covers required for sending question papers and outer envelope duly written to
 - > Remuneration Bills
- Paper Setters shall be requested to adhere to follow blooms taxonomy
- All the Question papers should be collected from the paper setters at least 1 week before the commencement of exams.
- Question papers received from the paper setters shall be Considerd by a scrutinizing team one hour before the start of that subject examination in confidential manner in the room of the Controller of Examinations on the day of examination. The scrutinizing team can modify wording or structure of questions but can not replace a question if the same is with in the prescribed syllabus. However, following the Blooms Taxonomy the scrutinizing team can change the questions up to 20 per cent of the entire question paper if it contains questions outside the prescribed syllabus.

As a part of implementation of autonomy it is necessary to frame our own procedure for Answer scripts evaluation.

Keeping in view the guidelines given by UGC, An Autonomous Examination Section was established with officer for conducting spot valuation to various courses of UG and PG Programmes. A systematic procedure for spot valuation process has been prepared by a committee appointed by the principal consisting of all the Heads of the departments. A series of meetings were held to meet necessary changes and for a making final draft. The spot valuation Process discussed in the Common BOS and suggested changes were made to propose to academic council.

The following is the Proposed procedure for the spot valuation Process;

- · All the answer scripts received by ACE are to be coded or pre-coded.
- · Panel of examiners will be communicated for spot valuation
- · List is to be prepared and examiners asked to attend
- Collection of detailed key (solutions cum scheme of valuation), which is prepared by course coordinator.
- · Spot valuation normally conducted between 9.30 AM to 4.30 PM.
- Maximum scripts given for each examiner is limited to 50 (fifty only) per day in two sessions of 25(twenty five) and 25 (twenty five).
- One Chief Examiner randomly evaluates 5 answer scripts from a bunch of 25 scripts which are already evaluated by the external examiner.
- If the deviation in marks noticed is equal to or greater than 15 per cent in 80 per cent of the
 revalued scripts between two examiners, then entire bundle has to be revaluated and further the
 examiner shall be advised to strictly follow the scheme of evaluation.
- The valuated answer scripts along with marks sheets signed by the examiner should hand over to the Chief Valuation Officer.
- The Chief Valuation Officer gets all the valued scripts scrutinized by scrutinizers appointed for this purpose. In case of any discrepancy it will be brought to the notice of the Chief Examiner of that Board who will arrange for correction on the answer script as well as marks statement. Each correction made on the script and on the marks statement has to be attested by the Examiner by an initial. All Corrections made in the Marks Statement has to be attested by the Chief Examiner besides the Examiner's initial.
- Award lists arranged in order shall be sent to the ACE for processing of results.
- The Valued Answer Scripts shall be re-bundled into 100s each (4 x 25) and shall be handed over to the ACE by the Chief Valuation Officer for safe custody.

Resolution

- I. Resolved as follows for UG Courses:
- 1. Each board of valuation shall have a Chief- Examiner who is the senior most among the examiners within the Institution.
- 2. Each board of valuation shall consist of 100 per cent of examiners from out side the institution.
- 3. In case of examiners within the institution, they shall be teachers who are competent to value a particular subject but did not give instruction for that particular regular batch of students whose papers are being valued.
- 4. Notwithstanding point (2) above, the Principal is authorized to appoint more number of teachers working within the institution and even those who had given instructions of a particular subject as examiners in case of emergency and shortage of examiners to complete the valuation within the prescribed time period.
- II. Resolved to have PG Courses with two examiners, one internal examiner within the Institution who has taught that subject acted as chief examiner and second examiner from outside the institution. In case the difference of marks of equal to or more than 15 per cent between the two examiners, such papers shall be sent to third valuation preferably to an examiner outside the institution. However, the Principal is authorized to get the third valuation done by an examiner within the institution but who has not given instruction and is competent to value the script(s).

Keeping in view the development of the Institution, it is requested to suggest and recommend any matter related to academic affairs for the development of the Institution. These recommendations shall be placed before the next Governing Council of the Institution for their consideration.

Resolved to suggest the following for the development of the Institution.

- 20% of the lab experiments shall be open ended problem solving experiments.
- 2. The number of experiments shall be two to three more than the AICTE / JNTUK prescribed number.
- 3. At least 20% of total syllabus shall be self learning periods and the video lecturers, given by eminent persons available in NPTL or else downloaded, of these topics shall be projected in the class room to students as a part of lecture/tutorial. The same may be given in soft copy form to the students or uploaded to the Institution website for students for their use.
- 4. Try to eliminate the chalk and talk method of teaching and should implement the modern methods of teaching by using the e- content.
