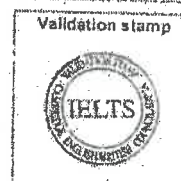

where
M is the marks obtained by the candidate in the paper, mentioned on this GATE 2018 scorecard
M_q is the qualifying marks for general category candidate in the paper
R_q is the mean of marks of top 0.1% or top 10 (whichever is larger) of the candidates who appeared in the paper (in case of multi-session papers including all sessions)
S_q = 350 is the score assigned to **M_q**
S_t = 900, is the score assigned to **M**.
